

MMOG training

MMOG, or **Materials Management Operations Guideline/Logistics Evaluation**, is a global standard for assessing and improving logistics operations and materials management in the supply chain. This standard was developed by **AIAG (Automotive Industry Action Group)** and **Odette International** to help companies evaluate and enhance their logistics processes, leading to increased efficiency and effectiveness across the entire supply chain.

MMOG/LE is particularly important for suppliers in the **automotive industry**, but its application extends to various other industrial sectors as well.
